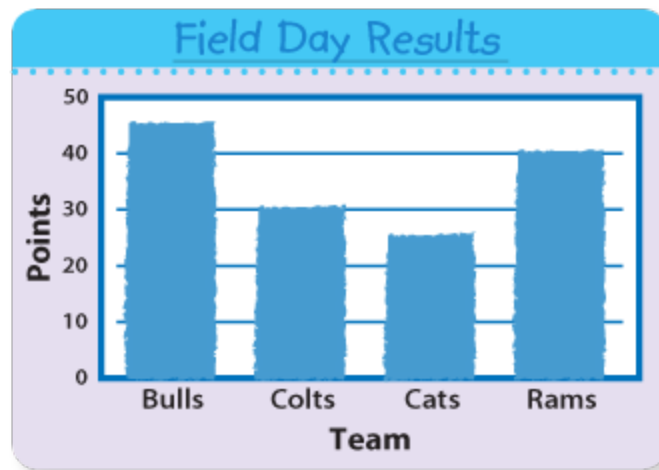

My Shoes

MATERIALS

Shoes, Paper, Pencil

ACTIVITY

Help your child make a bar graph that shows types of shoes. On the floor, arrange shoes in several categories that you agree on, such as: Sneakers, Sandals, Boots. Ask your child to count the pairs of shoes in each category and write down the numbers. Have your child draw a rectangle. At the top write "Shoes", at the left write "Pairs of Shoes", and at the bottom write each category. Determine a scale so that all the bars will fit inside the rectangle, then mark it on the graph. Have your child draw a bar to the correct height for each category.
