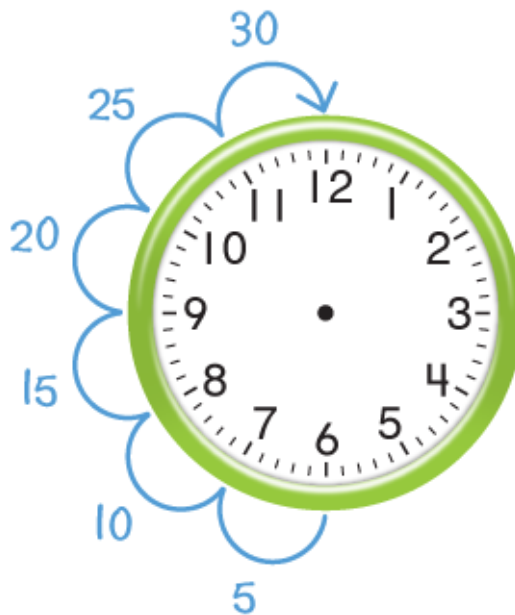

MATH HELP AT HOME

Sample Additional Practice Exercise 1

Find the elapsed time. Use the clock face or a number line to help.



Start Time: 3:30 P.M.

End Time: 7:00 P.M.

Elapsed Time:

3 hours, 30 minutes

To find the hour, count on from 3:30: 4:30, 5:30, 6:30. Three hours elapsed.

To find the minutes, count by 5s from the 6 to the 12: 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30. Thirty minutes elapsed.

What Time Will It Be?

ACTIVITY

Ask your child what time it will be in 30 minutes, 45 minutes, or 60 minutes from a given time. For example, you may tell your child that the family needs to be at the park 45 minutes from the given time. Then ask your child to tell you the time you should arrive at the park.
