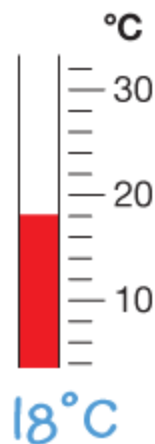

Sample Additional Practice Exercise 1

Write the temperature shown on the thermometer in $^{\circ}\text{C}$.



Each mark on the thermometer shows 2 degrees. Count up by 2s, starting at 10°C , until you reach the top of the red measure: 10, 12, 14, 16, 18°C .
